NOTICE OF PROPOSED CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT

This notice relates to the settlement of a class action lawsuit that stems from allegations that MFG.COM, INC. sent unsolicited advertisements by fax. If you received a fax offering information, services or products from MFG.COM, INC., your rights may be affected by a proposed settlement of a class action lawsuit.

If you are a member of the Class, then you can choose to stay in the Class or to exclude yourself from the Class.
